We hope to highlight a diversity of cultures, ideas, and traditions through the 2023 Celebrate South Salt Lake mini-grant program. Anyone may apply for support hosting their event!

What help can I get?

- Cash grant between \$500 - \$1,000 to help pay for event costs.
- Facility rental fee waiver if your event is held at a South Salt Lake facility (subject to availability).
- Fees waived for rental use of additional equipment (tables, chairs, A/V, etc.).
- Support from the SSL Arts Council and SSL Recreation sharing and/or posting your marketing materials to social media outlets and publishing it in the City newsletter (must meet necessary deadlines).
- If needed and within reason, training, tips, personal guidance on how to host a public event.

Who can apply?

- Anyone can apply! We are seeking a diversity of events and presenters.

What's the catch?

- Event must be:
 - **FREE** and open to the public.
 - Held at a public location in South Salt Lake.
 - Designed to support the mission of the SSL Arts Council to "Unite the SSL community through art."
